It is hereby enacted as follows :ô

1. This Acl may be called ihe Sundarbans Act, 1905.

2. [Repeal of enactments,]—Rep. by s. 3 and the Second Sell, of the Bengal Repealing and Amending Act, 1938 (Ben. Act. I of 1939).

3. All the powers and functions heretofore vested in, and exercised by, the Commissioner in the Sundarbans in any district shall henceforth be vested in, and exercisable by, the Collector of that district.
